Resolution Supporting the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers

Whereas the Boeing Company in violation of the National Labor Relations Act Retaliated against members of the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace workers-AFL-CIO for the union's lawful strikes during contract negotiations, by moving production of the 787 airplane to South Carolina;

And, whereas the Act guarantees the right to strike to all union members;

And, whereas the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers' Unfair Labor practice charge against the Boeing Company is a vital fight to protect their members rights under the Act;

And, whereas the outcome of this litigation will impact every union member in America regardless of union affiliation;

And, whereas an injury to one is an injury to all;

Be it resolved that the members and officers of the Musicians' Association of Seattle stand in solidarity with the IAMAW in the fight to preserve and protect Labor's hard fought and won right to collective bargaining, organizing and the right to strike;

And, be it further resolved that the Musicians' Association of Seattle shall forward this resolution to the American Federation of Musicians' International President, Raymond Hair, the Martin Luther King Jr. County Labor Council President, David Freiboth, Washington State Labor Council President Jeff Johnson, and AFL-CIO President Rich Trumka; and request that they inform and educate their affiliates about the IAMAW's Unfair Labor practice charge against the Boeing Company.

And be it resolved that by adoption of this resolution, we are requesting that members of all unions stand in solidarity with the IAMAW, and write letters to their elected officials supporting the Machinists and the National Labor Board's charge against the Boeing Company.


And, Be it finally resolved that a copy of this resolution be delivered to President Obama, Senator Murray, Senator Cantwell, the Washington State Congressional Delegation, Governor Gregoire and request that they support the NLRB's effort to protect workers' rights as guaranteed by the National Labor Relation Act.
